Legend and romance surround the vine called the passion flower - legend because of its historical associations with Christianity, and romance because of its suggestion of romantic passion. The legend is told that the passion flower's ten petals and sepals represent the ten apostles present at the crucifixion. The filaments portrayed the crown of thorns, or the halo about Jesus' head. The stamens, of which there are five, suggest the five wounds to Christ's hands, feet and torso. Other parts of the flower and leaves are also used to represent aspects of Christ's passion.


