Thrift Store News

Both Thrift Store locations need clothing, linens, and household items such as dishes, kitchen accessories, whatnots, etc.— these items sell quickly. Members are reminded that donations of garments and household items (furniture and bedding too) are also needed.

Unusable computers, televisions, all electronics, anything metal including wire coat hangers can also be sold for recycling. Garments can be in ANY condition because income is also derived from rag sales. (The value of your donation is tax deductible and a receipt will be provided by store staff.)
