The Thrift Store needs clothing, linens, and household items such as dishes, kitchen accessories, whatnots, etc.– these items sell quickly. Members are reminded that donations of garments and household

items (*furniture and bedding too*) are also needed. Unusable computers, televisions, all electronics, anything metal including wire coat hangers can also be sold for recycling. Garments can be in *ANY condition* because income is also derived from *rag sales*. (The value of your donation is tax deductible and a receipt will be provided by store staff.)
