

Christmas Stockings

Stocking Instructions

We thank you for your help in filling stockings. Please print the age and sex of the child on the top portion of the label under the statement "JESUS IS THE REASON FOR THE SEASON".

Instructions and example below:

Infants age 0 to 11 months, boy or girl

All others label one (1) stocking per age up to 12 years

1-year-old child - label stocking 1-year-old boy or 1-year-old girl

2 years old child - label stocking 2-year-old boy or 2-year-old girl

3 years old child - label stocking 3-year-old boy or 3-year-old girl

And so on up to 12 years old.
