Updates

Salvation Army feeding and service operations continue in response to Hurricane Sandy.

- The most heavily impacted areas including **New York** and **New Jersey** where coastal devastation and flooding remain major issues.
- West Virginia and Maryland are facing a different kind of disaster with record snowfalls leaving thousands without power.
- Salvation Army **personnel are continuing to assess damage today** and are moving to the areas of greatest need in coordination with Emergency Management personnel.

Monetary donations are the most critical need as supplies and personnel move into the areas of greatest need.

- The Salvation Army is extremely gratified for the continued support of the donating public.
- To date, the Army has received **nearly \$700,000 in online donations** alone to support relief efforts.
